Duties and Responsibilities:

- Communicate effectively with children who have learning difficulties.
- Assist teacher in small group teaching using a variety of teaching aids.
- Assist occupational therapists during a group therapy session.
- Prompt children to engage in a given task (music, art, storytelling, table task, etc.)

Qualifications and Education Requirements:

- A second or third year undergraduate in the field of Psychology or Education is preferred.

As an intern, these are some of the things that you will learn from working with our team:

- Use various accommodations and modifications to individualize the learning approach for children with speech-language difficulties.
- Understand the physical and emotional needs of a child with learning difficulties from the perspectives of SEN teachers and therapists.
- Effectively use different ways of prompting a child (visual, physical, verbal, etc.)
- Increase awareness on the range of individual with intellectual and developmental disabilities.



About us

Sri Eden was founded in 2000 as a private establishment which caters to the needs of children with special needs by five ladies who were drawn to the needs of these children. We started off with only three teachers. In 2009, we transitioned into a non-profit Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) as there was a higher need to serve children with special needs in the underprivileged community. In year 2012, we recruited our first speech therapist as we had a large number of children with speech and language difficulties. Two years later, we started providing occupational therapy for these children.

Currently we are operating as a special needs center with a multidisciplinary team, catering to a holistic intervention approach for children with diverse learning needs. These children comprise of those with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Down's syndrome, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), and undiagnosed conditions. Our team consists of 17 special education teachers, 2 occupational therapists and 1 speech therapist.
